Every year nearly 45 to 50 thousand students pass diploma engineering in various disciplines. Diploma Engineering pass outs mainly support the middle level management of an industry. In the discussions with many institutes it is observed that 75 to 80% students tend to secure higher education (Degree in Engg.). It is creating imbalance in availability of technical human resource in the industry. Therefore, it is the job of every institute to motivate students for joining industry after they receive their diploma and also to create opportunities to the students by inviting industries for placement. It is observed that industry normally do not prefer to go to rural institutions for placements. This results in lack of opportunity for students of rural areas. Institutes located in urban areas or areas where industry population is high, can hold campus interview for final year students. However, industry observes that most of the selected students are less inclined to join the industry. This may be due to the fact that the meritorious students only get selected by industry for placement. Therefore, almost all the students those have been selected in campus interview, take-up the choice of higher education rather than opting for job.

In view of this, MSBTE has decided to address this issue and come out with a solution so as to ensure the reach of campus interview benefits to needy students as well. We are planning to call meeting of TPO's of diploma engineering institutes affiliated to MSBTE. The date of meeting will be shortly declared and communicated by this office. A model will be formulated to achieve this task through pool campus.

To Co-ordinate and enhance the placement of students, all the institutions must have a TPO cell. Institutions where full time / regular TPO is not appointed, you are requested to appoint a TPO or assign this activity to the teacher who is dynamic and capable of carrying out this activity.

You are also informed to prepare the following information in the formats enclosed on priority basis and send the same immediately. Pl. treat this as urgent.
